I support residents daily with a broad range of issues both individually and groups of residents. It is important to share concerns in order to find positive solutions.

Continually working to build community groups/spirit, throughout Dyfan. Organising/running events and creating community spaces.

In White Farm Park I am working closely with the Council and Ecologists, to make areas of useable community space but also maintaining the biodiversity of this newly adopted SSI park.

Holding well attended events in Highlight Park including Summer Festivals, Film Events, Defibrillator Training, curry and quiz night and successful Easter events in Buttrills and Family Funday in Colcot.

I organise public PACT meetings across the ward. The Police and Vale Enforcement Officers attended to talk face-to-face about residents' problems and concerns. I regularly attend Neighbourhood Watch and residents' meetings.

I have taken the lead in reopening Buttrills Community Centre. I am pleased that the centre is building and now holds regular community events as well as providing space for regular users and affordable hire.

With a dedicated group of volunteers, I have created a weekly Warmspace at Buttrills Community Centre every Friday 11-2pm, providing free lunches, snacks and drinks. This runs alongside an open access Foodbank (including Pet food) and is open to everyone in these difficult times of high living costs. Free period dignity products are also available from the centre. I am usually present and now floating support workers attend, providing additional support if required.
