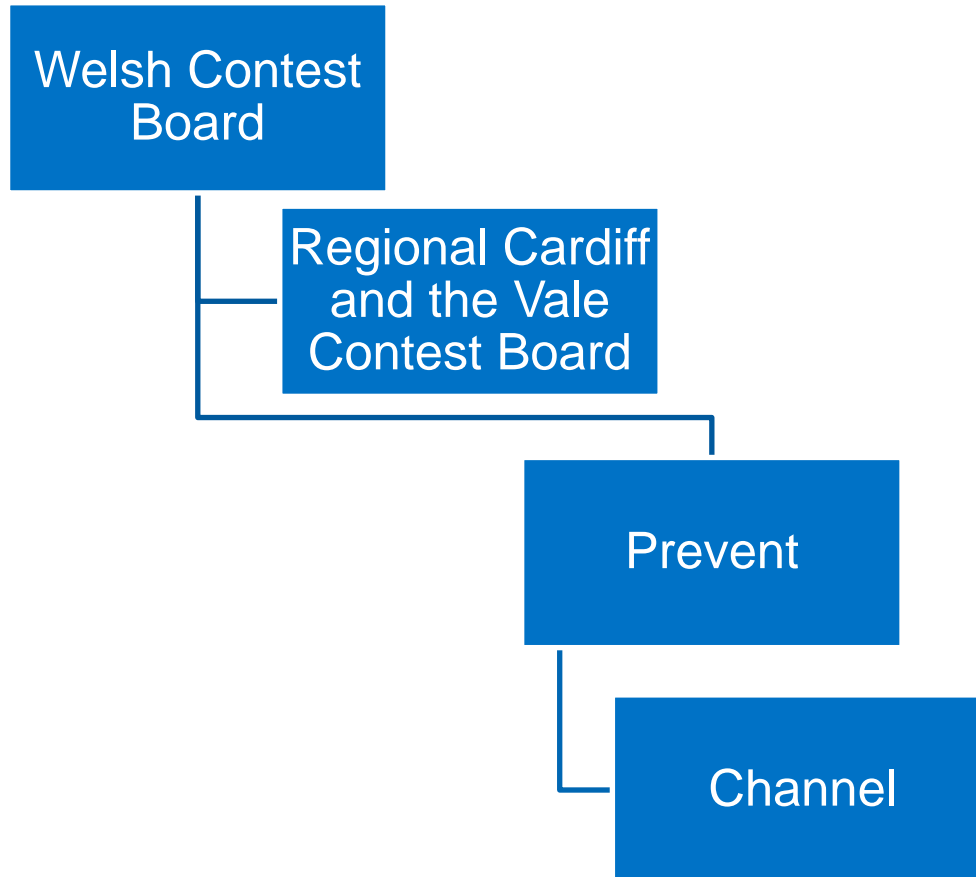

What is Prevent?

"The aim of the Prevent strategy is to reduce the threat to the UK from terrorism by stopping people becoming terrorists or supporting terrorism"

- Safeguarding those at risk
- Deals with all forms of extremism
- Multi-agency approach to supporting the person
- Approved Intervention Providers, experts in their field

Understanding Risk and Threat

- Counter Terrorism Local Profile
 - Police prepare and send to the Council
 - Referral data
 - Channel data
 - Incident summary –local, regional, national
 - Pursue data
 - Estimated threat –looking forward and back
- Creating a risk assessment

Training

WRAP remains the standard tool for those likely to come into contact with those at risk of radicalisation

E-learning is available for those who require a base level of knowledge

Making a Referral

Notice

Practitioner has a concern about an individual in relation to radicalisation

Check

Are there reasons for the change in behaviour?

Share

Discuss concerns with colleagues/safeguarding lead

Refer

If concerns remain, make formal referral to Police

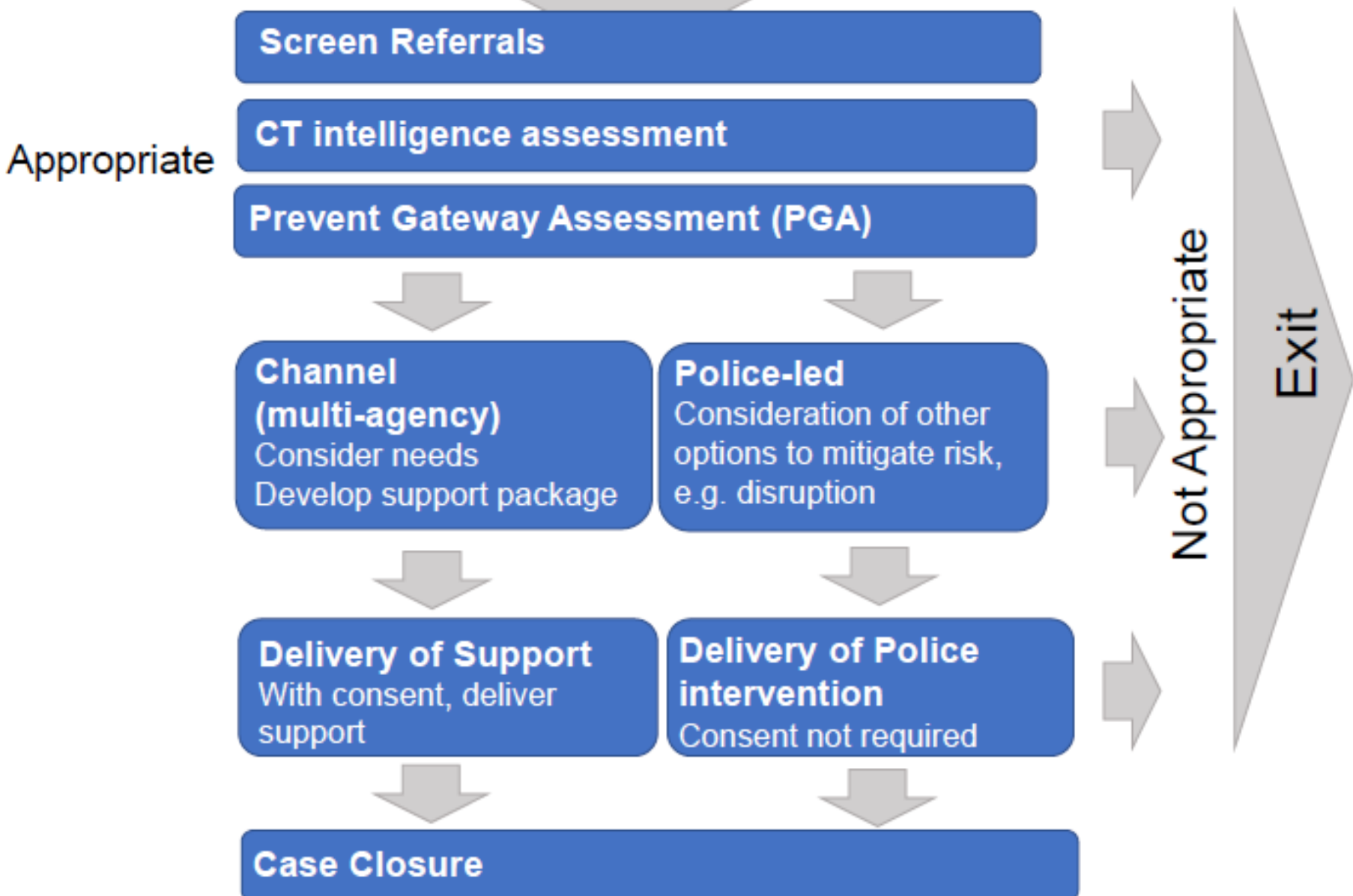

What is channel?

- Multi-agency safeguarding meeting
- Early support for individuals vulnerable to being drawn into terrorism
- Benefits of a multi-agency approach
 - Identifying individuals at risk
 - Assessing the nature and extent of that risk
 - Building tailored support plans
