Executive Summary:

Reason for Recommendation

1. To comply with the regulations and obligations for the grant of dispensations to speak and vote.

1. Background

- **1.1** The Standards Committee Grant of Dispensations (Wales) Regulations 2001 permits Members to apply to Standards Committee to speak and, if appropriate, to vote on issues which due to prejudicial interests, they may not otherwise be able to speak or vote or remain in the room.
- **1.2** In order to deal with the applications as quickly as possible, it is necessary for the Standards Committee to receive full information of the interests involved and why in the Member's opinion dispensation should be given.
- **1.3** Applicants are advised that they are also able to attend the Standards Committee meeting to present their application if they wish to do so.
- 1.4 All Vale of Glamorgan Councillors and Town and Community Councils have been advised that previous applications that had been agreed during the last term of office ceased at the time of the Local Government elections held on 5th May 2022.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

- **2.1** Committee is requested to consider and determine applications for dispensation from the following Councillors as attached at Appendix 1 to this report:
- Cowbridge with Llanblethian Town Councillor D. Breen to speak only when matters relating to the Cowbridge Museum (which is located within Cowbridge Town Hall) are discussed in view of being a Trustee of the museum and Chair of Cowbridge with Llanblethian's Town Hall Committee.
- Colwinston Community Councillor B. Morris to speak and vote when matters related to planning consent for extension to Heol Cae Pwll Estate are discussed at meetings of Colwinston Community Council due to living on the estate where permission to build extension is being sought.
- Vale of Glamorgan Councillor M. Hooper to speak and vote on broad matters relating to the Welsh Government's Climate Change portfolio (save for matters regarding Ynni Cymru or Unnos) when they are to be discussed at Vale of Glamorgan Council meetings for the period of his employment as a Special Advisor in Welsh Government.

2.2 The Standards Committee agreed that when applications for dispensation are required to be considered as a matter of urgency, the Monitoring Officer in consultation with the Chair of the Standards Committee be provided with the authority to consider such applications and to report to a future meeting such applications that have been agreed under this delegated authority.

3.1 One of the roles and functions of the Standards Committee (as detailed in the Council's Constitution) is to consider the granting of dispensations to Councillors, Co-opted Members and Church and Parent Governor Representatives from requirements relating to interests set out in the Members' Code of Conduct.
