What do we do?

We offer a counselling and community care service.

The counselling service offers the chance to talk privately with a fully trained counsellor. You can discuss whatever problems you are experiencing and the service is free of charge

The community care service provides an assessment and case management role under the legislative framework of the NHS and Community Care Act 1990. Working with someone in their own community with appropriate support, or a formal package of residential rehabilitation are examples of what we can offer. All support packages are agreed between the service user and the social worker.

We also offer various group work to service users of the agency which include Auricular Acupuncture, Relapse Prevention and Relaxation

Who is the service for?

The service is available to anyone who is concerned about his/her alcohol or drug abuse. The counselling service also offers support to family and friends who are concerned about someone else's drinking or drug use
